
& South Peace



These graphs display the results of the 2016 regional research trials conducted in the Peace Regions. The triticale plots at the South Peace research farm were not harvested in 2016 due to the early snowfall. Triticale is a small – grain cereal developed to combine the quality and uniformity attributes of wheat with the vigour and hardiness of rye. Most varieties currently available mature approximately 10 days later than CWRS wheat, which makes triticale not ideal for the short growing

season in the Peace Region.







In 2016, the weather stations at the North and South Peace research farms recorded a combined precipitation amount of 801 ml between May 1st and September 30th. 220 ml above the normal average!
