

HAVE YOU FILED A NOTICE OF LOSS?

- Filing a Notice of Loss each time a weather event may have impacted your crop is a critical requirement of your insurance policy. More importantly, it allows us to get to your farm in time to properly assess any potential loss.
- This must be done before the crop is harvested, abandoned or put to an alternative use (baling, silage, grazing, tilling under)!
- **Not** filing a Notice of Loss on time could potentially reduce an indemnity.
- Notify the Production Insurance office by phoning, faxing or emailing us immediately.
- Please note: Due to COVID-19, Ministry of Agriculture offices in FSJ and DC are still closed to the public. If you require a personal appointment, a farm visit by one of our staff can be arranged.
